

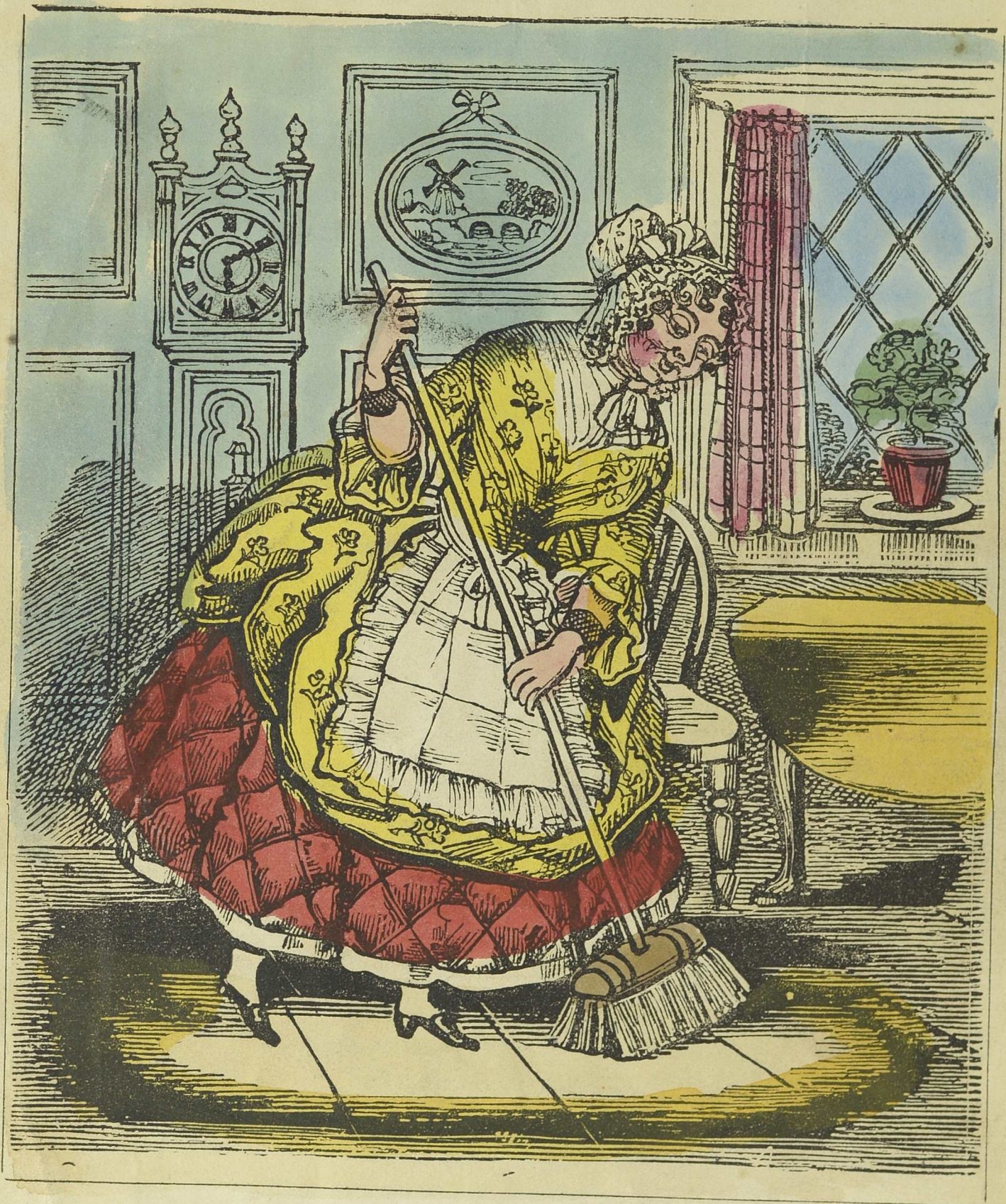

LITTLE DAME CRUMP.



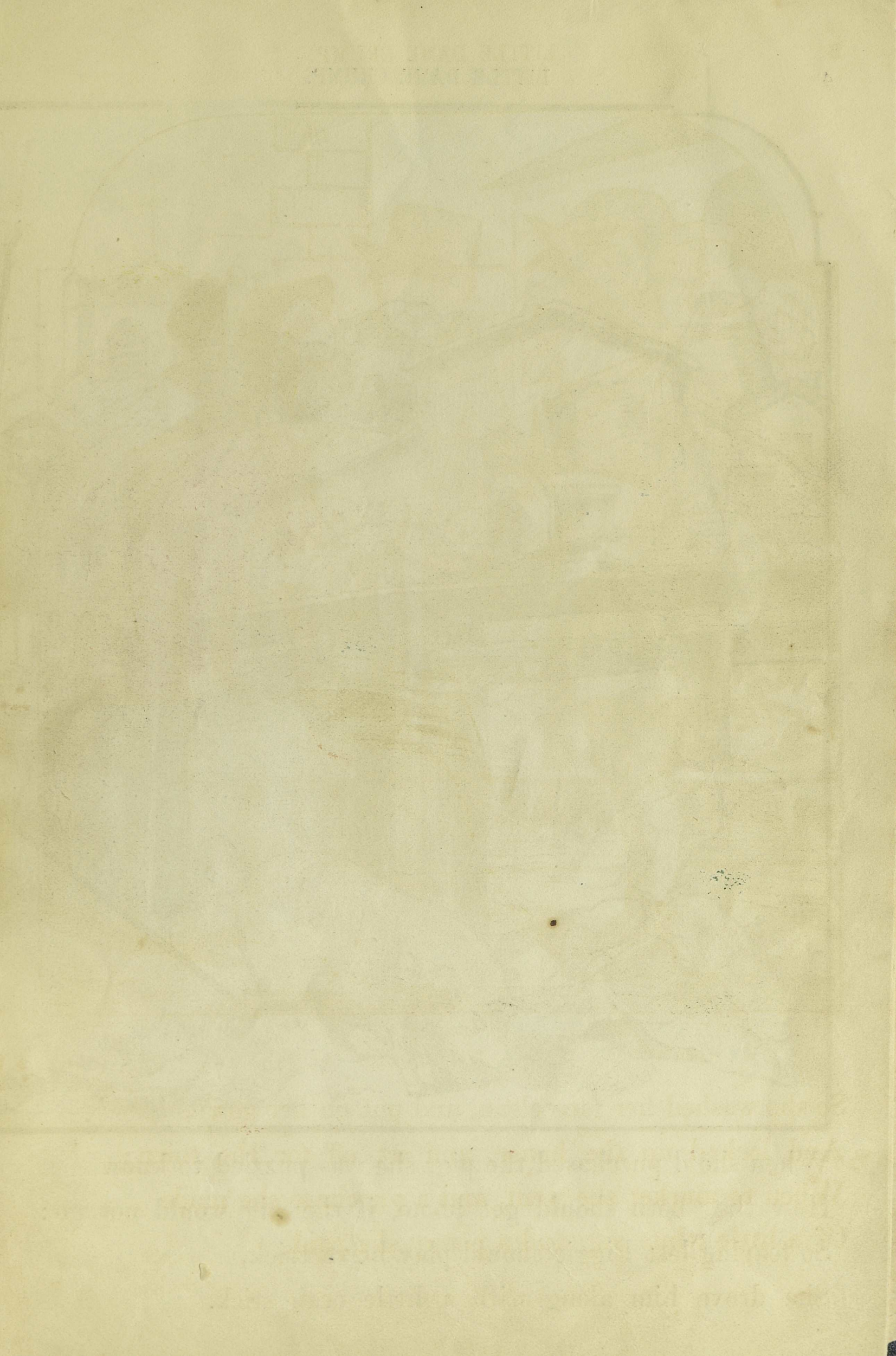
Little Dame Crump, with her little hair broom,

And little John Gubbins shall make him a stye.”



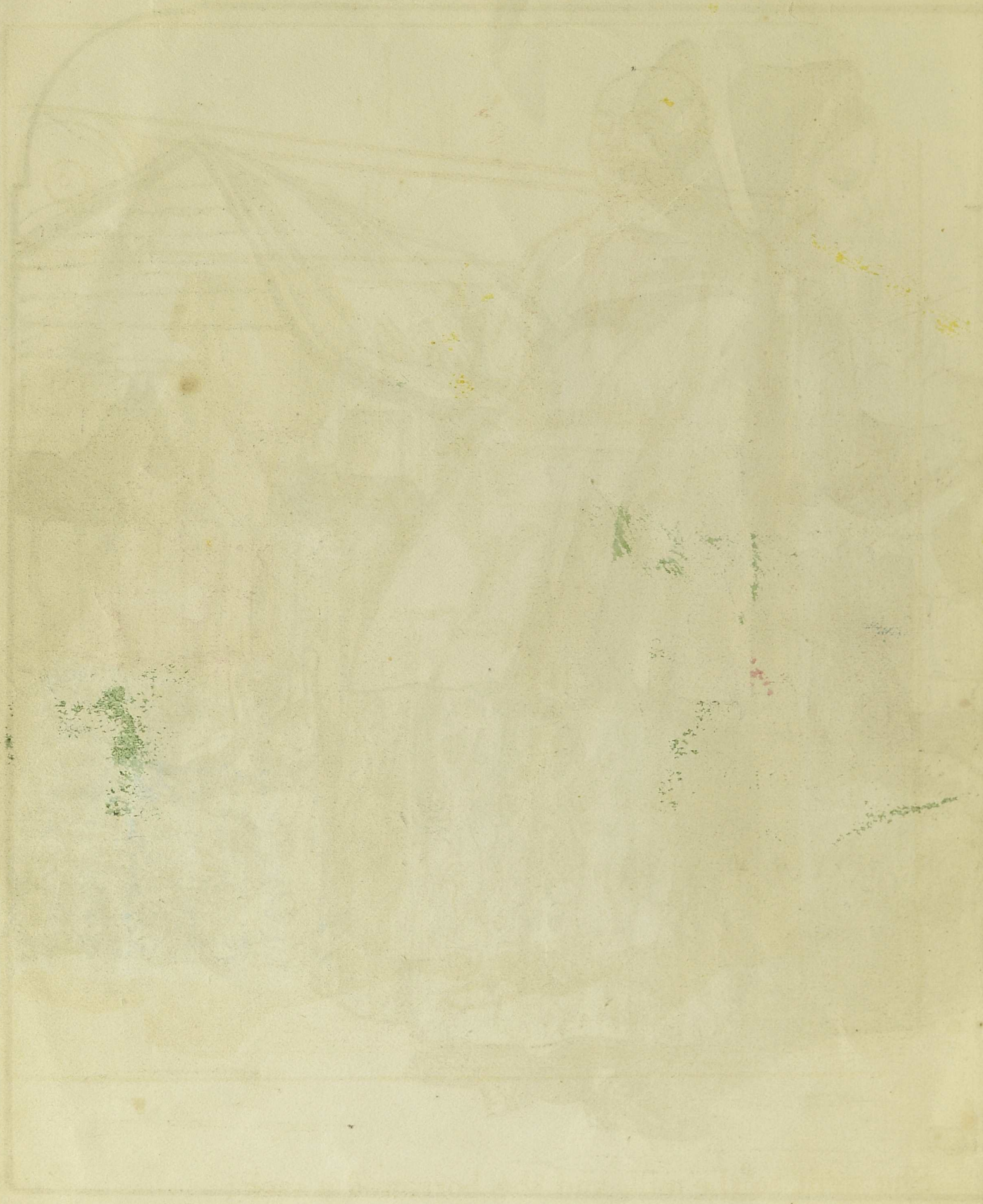
So she washed her face clean, and put on her gown,

 She drove him along with a little crab stick.

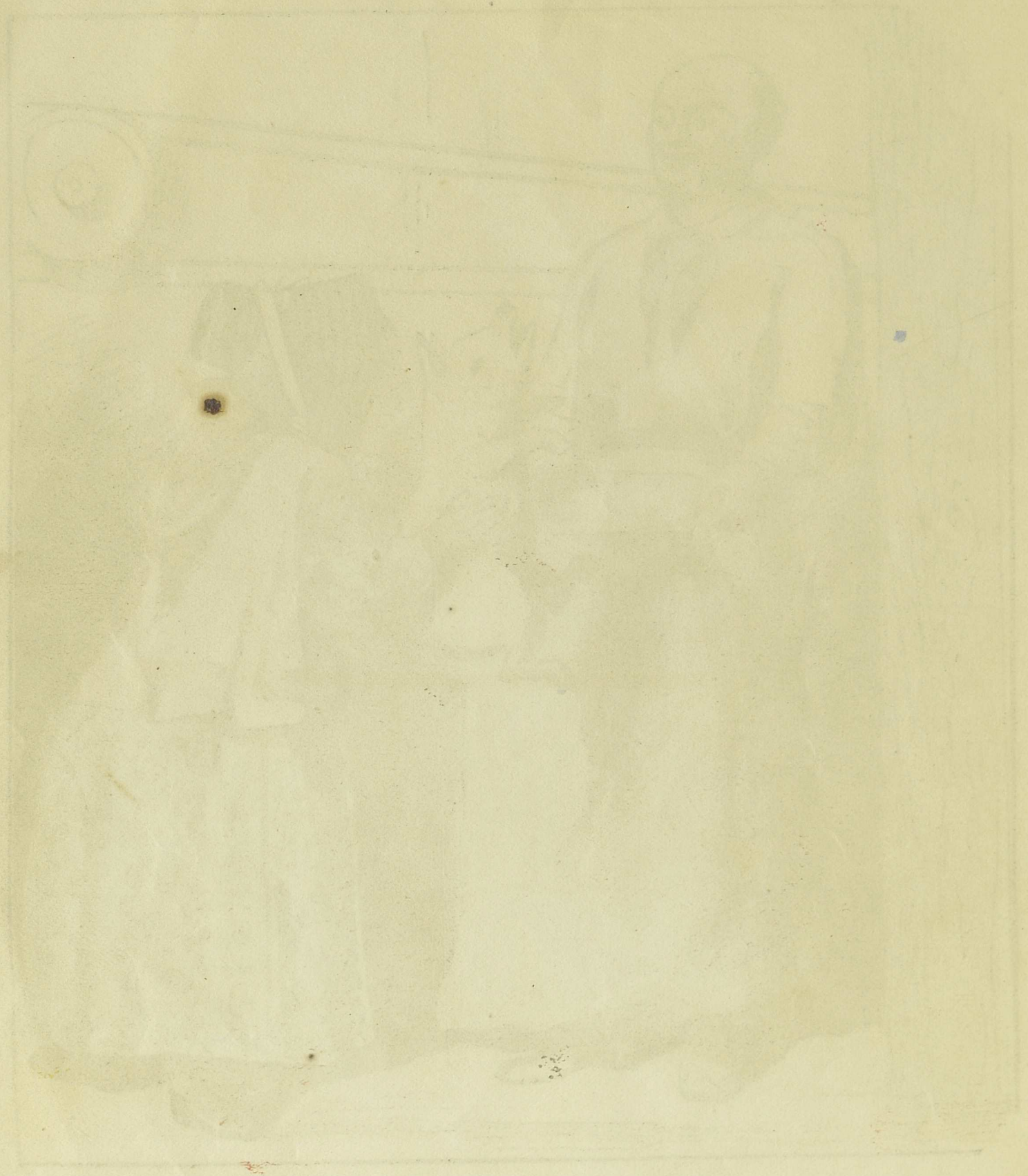
Piggie ran till they came to the foot of a hill,

 Oh, fie! Piggie, fie! to serve little Dame so.



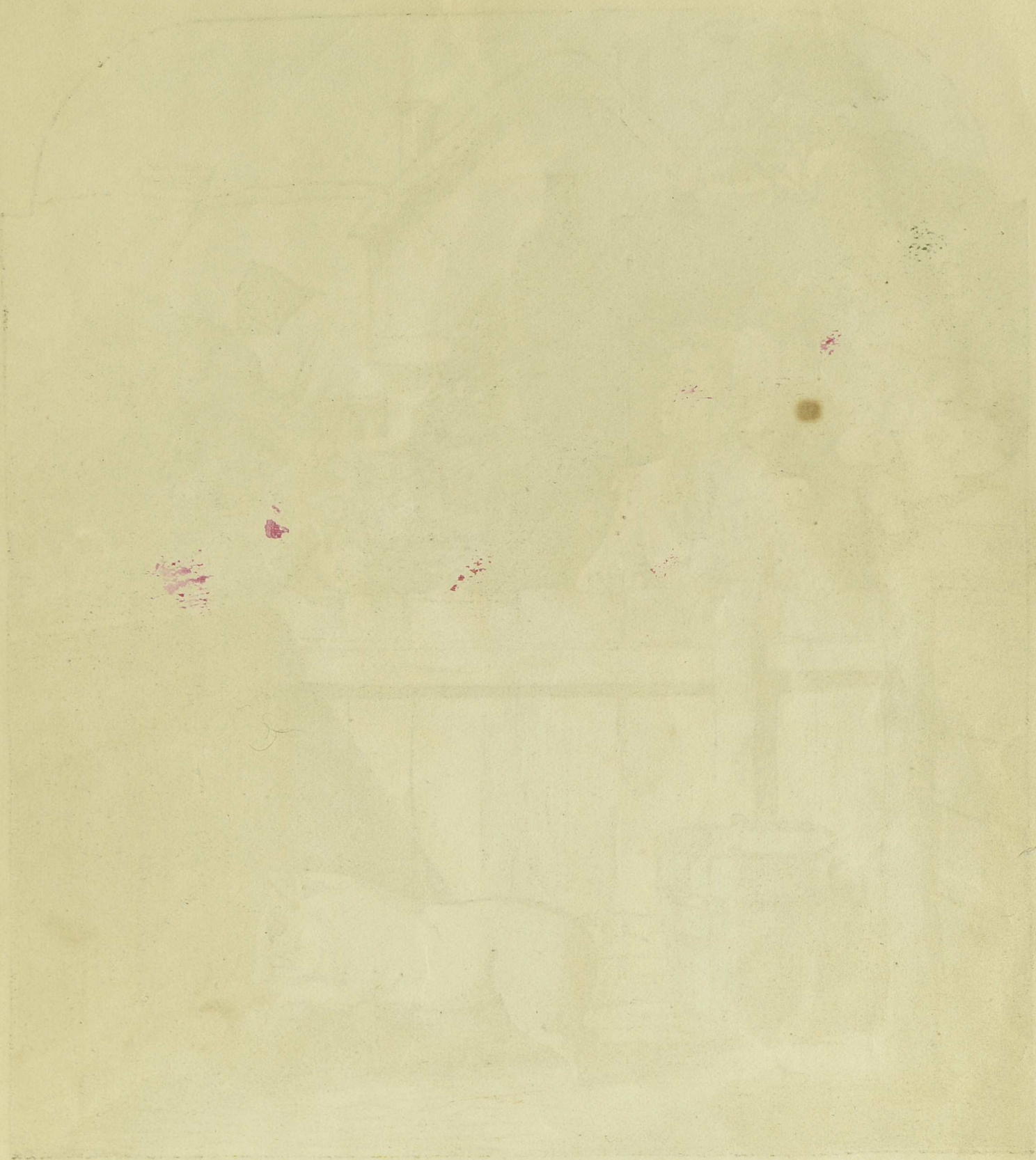

“If you won't go by fair means, why, you must be made.”

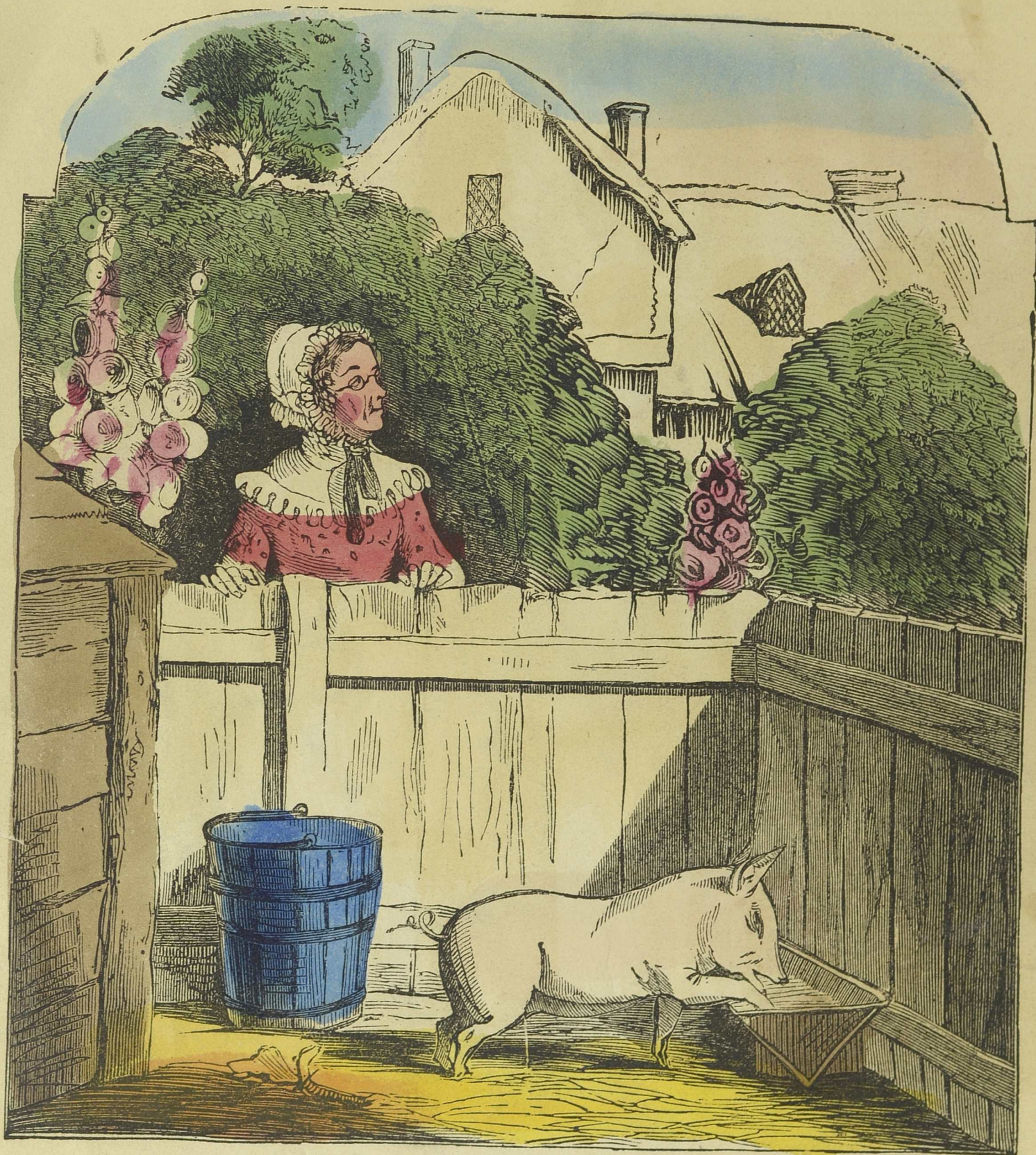


She went to the mill and she borrowed a sack.
