This twist has the same effect upon the stitch and seam as the twisting of the strands of a rope together, producing elasticity, and gathering; into a yielding power all the strength of the individual strands, making the aggregate strength much more than the combined strength of the individual threads or strands before being twisted. It is more reliable than any other stitch, while it *may* be raveled by a certain process, *when necessary*, and it is far less liable to rip than the "shuttle" stitch. It uses stik, linen thread, or common spool cotton; and upon any grade of fabric, at the rate of 1,000 stitches per minute. A child can use the Victoria Sewing Machine with perfect success, there being no complicated machinery accomplished with this Machine, while it is apparent to every one that no Machine using the shuttle stich, as eadly anything at all towards making such ornamental work.
