AN ACT

For granting to His Majesty a certain sum of Money out of the Funds applicable to the uses of this Province, to defray the Expences of Amending and Repairing the Public Highways and Roads, and building Bridges in the feveral Districts thereof.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

WHEREAS it would much advance the general prosperity of this Province, and greatly facilitate the public fervice, if the public Highways and Roads were amended: May it please your Majetly, that it may be ecacted, and be it enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confint of the Legislative Counciland Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled " An Act to repeal certain " parts of an act passed in the funteenth year of his Majeily's Reign, " entired " An Act for making more of effectual provision for the Government, of the prevince of Quebec in North America and to make further pro-" vision for the Government of the laid Province," and by the authority of the same. That out of the Rates and Duties already railed, levied and collected, or hereafter to be railed levied and collected, there he granted to His Majelly His Heirs and fucceffors the fum of his thouland pounds to be iffined out of the funds now remaining or hereafter to come into the Receiver General's hands unappropriated, and ariling from such rates and duties as last aforefaid, which faid fum of fix thouland pounds shall be disposed of, appropriated and applied in opening new Roads, repairing the roads already laid out and in building Bridges in the leveral Districts of this Province.

II. And be it further enasted by the authority aforefaid, That the faid fum of fix thousand pounds shall be appropriated in the following manner, that is to tay, to the Eastern Diffrict, one Confaud pounds, which faid four of one thouland rounds shall be laid out and expended in the following manner, that is to fay, one hundred a dishirty feven pounds ten thillings to be laid out or Pounoyer's Road in front of the township of Maillia; One hundred and thirty feven pounds ten childings for the Tow, thip of Williamsburg; one bundled pounds for the township of Osnabuck; two hundred and seventy five for the main road common ing at John Matrices Jun. in the Township of Cornwall leading through the back tettlement by and over the bridge of the River aux Reifin at McMartin's Mill till it arrives at the Province line of Lower Canada; Fifty pounds to be laid out on the read leading from the Town of Cornwall to the laid main road below St. And ews. Church on the River max Raifin in the faid Township of Cornwall; Three hundred pounds to be laid out and expended in building Bridges, opening and repairing the roads as follows, beginning at or near the Stone House of John Grant in Hisz-kesbury in the county of Prescott, from thence on the road laid out by Alex'r. Grant, surveyor of reads, until it interfects the road between Lots number nine and ten in the western Division of Hawkesbury, from thence between faid lots, to the conceifion road between the fifth and fixth conceifions; and from thence on the mad known by the road laid out by Joseph Fortune to the fielt fettlements in the country of Glengary; offo the Public money in the hands of Alexander Grant unexpended, to be laid out on the road as above described

For the Diffrict of Johnstown, one thousand pounds, which said sum of one thousand pounds, shall be laid but and expended in the following manner, that is to fay, fix hundred pounds on the front or Penn yer's road leading from the Eastern District to the Midiand District, and passing Adam Coles in front of Elizabethtown; and four hundred pounds on the road leading from Daniel Jones's front Mills in Elizabethtown afore aid to the faid Midland District, and passing Justice Scelye's in Elizabethtown aforesaid, and the surnace in the rear of

Lanfdown in the faid Diffrict of Johnstown.

To the Midland Dittrict, seven hundred pounds, which faid sum of seven hundred pounds shall be laid out & expended in the following manner, that is to fay, on the road leading from the Carrying place head of the Bay of Quiaty to Townsand Carman's thro' the township of Ameliasburg, eighty pounds; on the road from Vanaliline's Mills to Thomas Eyres in Hallowell twenty pounds; from the western Boundary of the Township of Richmond, to the eaftern boundary of the township of Thurlow, two hundred pounds; from the Napanee Mills to Kingston on the back road, two hundred pounds; from Kingston Eastward, Two hundred pounds.

To the Diffrict of Newcastle, five hundred pounds, which said sum of five hundred pounds shall be laid out and expended in the following manner, that is to fay, on the road leading from the carrying place at the head of the bay of Quinty to the cast corner of lot number one in the second Concession of the township of Cramahe, one hundred pounds; on the road leading from the River Trent to the call corner of ot number one in the fecond concession of the township of Cramane, one hundred pounds; On Dundas street through the Townships of Hope, Clarke and Darlington, two hundred and fifty pounds; in repairing bridges and making Causeways

on the road through the Townships of Cramahe, Haldimand and Hamilton, fifty pounds

For the Home Diffrict, one thousand pounds, which said sum of one thousand pounds, shall be laid out and expended in the following manner, that is to fay, cast of the Town of York, that is to fay, on the l'unday road through Whitby and Pickering, in erecting a bridge over the river Nen, on the road through Scarborough, and creeting a bridge over the river Don, on the Dundas road near the Town of York, the fum of fix hundred pounds; and from the town of York weltward, the fum of four hundred pounds; to be applied in the following manner, for building a bridge across the Humber at or near Cooper's Mills on the Dundas Street, one hundred pounds, and for Canfewaying the road from thence to the river Credit the fum of two hundred pounds, and for opening the Street on each fide the river Credit through the Indian Reserve, forty pounds; and upon the road leading from Dundas Street to Dundas Mills, the fum of fixty pounds.

For the District of Niagara, six hundred pounds, which said sum of six hundred pounds shall be laid out and expended in the following manner, that is to fay, on the Grand River Swamp from Vanderlips to Fairchilds Creek two hundred and lifty pounds; from Stony Creek to the forty mile Creek one hundred pounds; from the forty mile creek to the twelve mile creek fifty pounds; from the twelve mile creek to Niagara, middle road. fixty pounds; from the twelve mile creek to enechflown, by At. Davids, fixty pounds; from St. Davids down the four mile creek to Seroos's fifty pounds; and for the Bridge at Mr. Beafley's creek, thirty pounds.

Two the Diffrict of Loudon, fix hundred pounds, which said sum of fix hundred pounds stall be laid out and expended in the following manner, that is to say; on Talbot road from big exceck to port Talbot, and from thence to Delaware in such places as the commissioners may deem most expedient, three hundred pounds; from Yeighs to Delaware, one hundred and fifty pounds; from Hart Smith's to Big creek, following the Windham line, seventy sive pounds, on the back road through Charlotteville and Walfingham to Talbot road Seventy sive pounds.

To the Western District six hundred pounds, which said sum of six hundred pounds shall be laid out and expended in the sollowing manner, that is to say, in the wilderness between Delaware and Moravian Town, four hundred pounds; from Moravian Town to Sandwich, one hundred pounds; from Sandwich to Amherstburgh, one hundred pounds; Provided always, and be it further enacted, that no part of the said sum abovementioned shall be expended as aforesaid, unless the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Governor.

ment shall give special directions to that effect-

it shall and be it further enasted by the authority aforesaid, that at any time from and after the passing of this A& it shall and may be sawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this province to appoint one Commissioner for each of this aforesaid Districts of this Province for carrying the provisions of this act into execution, which commissioner shall have full power and authority, and he is hereby required to proceed to repair and amend such roads and build such bridges in each and every of the aforesaid districts as herein before described to which he shall be respectively appointed, and the said commissioner shall cause the work required by this a& to be done or performed on or before the sufficient of September 1 mext. Provided always, that in the Eastern District there may be two commissioners, one of whom shall reside in the county of Prescott.

IV. And be it further enasted by the authority aforesaid. That the faid commissioner appointed by this act, shall on or before the first day of January, transmit to the Governor Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this Province a true account of the expenditures of the money by him received under and by virtue of this act, (in detail) with proper vouchers accompanying the same to be laid before the Legisla-

ture for their inspection.

V. And be it further enalted by the authority aforefaid, that it shall and may be lawful for the Governor Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this Province to direct the money appropriated and apportioned as aforesaid for each and every district thereof to be paid to the commissioner for such district as may be appropriated: Provided always, that if any of the said sums of money herein before granted shall not be expended on the Highways before the first day of September next, each and every commissioner appointed by writtee of this act shall be obliged to repay to the Receiver General of this Province all such sum or sums of money unexpended as shall be by him received under the authority of this act.

VI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That before any commissioner shall proceed to carry into execution the several powers and authorities by this act composed he shall take the following Oath, II A.B. do swear that I will saithfully and impartially to the best of my skill and indigenent perform and carry into execution the several powers and authorities in me vested in and by a certain act of the Legislature of this Province," entituled, "an act for granting to His Majesty a certain sum of money out of the sunds applicable to the uses of this Province to desay the expenses of amending and repairing the pulssic Highways & roads and building bridges in the several districts thereof," without favor or affection to any person or persons whomsoever, and will duly and faithfully account for all monies which shall from time to time come into my hands for the purpose of carrying the provisions of the said act into execution, so help one God?" Which said Oath shall be taken before any one of his Majesty's Judices of the Peace in and for the district for which such commissioner shall be appointed, and a certificate of such Oath, the Justice administering the sum is hereby required to transmit to the clerk of the House of Assembly of this Province with all convenient speed after such Oath shall have been by him administered.

VII. Provided nevertheles, and it is hereby declared that nothing herein contained shall repeal or amend any of the provisions of any existing act or acts of this Province contained, for raising or leaving the Rates thereby imposed or compelling the dabor by such acts or in any of them required to be done and performed on any public Highways and roads comprised in such acts, but all and every such act or acts is and are declared to be and continue in full force; provided also that nothing is any former Law or statute of this. Province contained shall from and after the passing of this act, be held and construed to empower or authorize any Magistrate or overfeer in any such Law or Statute mentioned in any manner to interfere or give directions touching or concerning any road or Highway to be laid out or repaired under or by virtue of this act; nevertheless the said Magistrate and overfeer and every of them is and are hereby authorized to carry into execution all and every such power and authority as by such law or statute they are vested with, an all cases in which the executing such power will not impose to interfere with the powers or authorities given in and the virtue of this act.

will not impede by interfere with the powers or authorities given in and by sirtue of this act.

VIII. And be it further enalted by the authority aforefait. That the money hereby granted to His Majelty that be paid by the Receiver General is discharge of such warrant or warrants as shall for the purpose herein set for the issued by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this Province and the Receiver General shall account to His Majelty his Heirs and successors for the same, through the Lords commissioners of His Majelty's treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majelty, his

Heirs and successors shall be graciously pleased to direct.
